## 2021 DISTRICT 12 ONTARIO HORTICULTURAL ASSOCIATION CENTENNIAL BURSARY

A bursary of \$500.00 will be awarded annually to a student from the geographical area of District 12 of the Ontario Horticultural Association. This district takes in the area from Temagami to Hearst.
